Waiver of Liability:

I hereby accept any and all responsibility for and assume the risk of any and all injury or damage to my person or dependent children which might arise directly as a result, of participation in the Shelby YMCA and its activities, the various branches and subdivisions thereof, and all employee and volunteers in their capacities as representatives of the Shelby YMCA expressly including, but not limited to, the Board of Directors of the Shelby YMCA except for injuries caused intentionally, or by willful misconduct. I certify that I am familiar with the contents of this release, that I have read and understand the same, and that it is my intention by my heirs, administrators, executors, successors, and assigns.

- **Property Loss:** I understand that the Shelby YMCA is **not** responsible for personal property lost, damaged, or stolen while members and/or program participants are using Shelby YMCA facilities or on Shelby YMCA program premises.
- **Photography Permission:** I give my permission for the Shelby YMCA to use, without limitation or obligation, photographs, film footage, or tape recordings, which may include my image or voice for purposes of promoting or interpreting Shelby YMCA programs.
- **Insurance:** I understand it is my responsibility to provide for my own (and other members of my family if applicable) accident and health coverage while participating in all Shelby YMCA activities. The Shelby YMCA does not provide any accident or health insurance for its participants.
- **Medical Release:** I authorize the Shelby YMCA as my agent, to give consent to surgical or medical treatment by a licensed physician or hospital when such treatment is deemed necessary by the physician if I cannot be contacted within a reasonable time or otherwise unable to give such consent. I authorize the Shelby YMCA to give first aid, CPR or other treatment by a qualified staff member.
- **Acceptance:** This waiver and release is given for myself and on behalf of all the minor members of my family or in my care, if any. If any portions of this waiver are held to be invalid, I agree that the remaining terms shall continue to be full legal force and effect.
- **Coronavirus, COVID-19:** This virus is very contagious and spreads through person to person contact. I certify that I have full knowledge of the nature and extent of the risks inherent in participation at the Shelby YMCA and I assume all risks and will solely be responsible for any contagion I may be exposed to or receive.

SHELBY YMCA RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

It is the intent of the Shelby YMCA to provide a safe and friendly environment for all members, volunteers, and staff. We strive to have our members and staff exemplify an attitude of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. Please join us as we strive to strengthen the foundations of this community by supporting youth development, promoting healthy living and committing to our social responsibility.

- Please present your membership card upon entry to the facility.
- All persons using the facility or grounds are expected to follow all YMCA policies and procedures and to conduct themselves appropriately. Physical or verbal abuse, sexual innuendo or display, or offensive behavior of any kind is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- It is illegal to carry a firearm, deadly weapon, or dangerous ordnance in the YMCA building.
- The YMCA is a smoke, vape, drug, and alcohol-free facility. This also includes its grounds.
- The possession or sale of any drugs or drug paraphernalia will lead to prosecution to the fullest extent of the law.
- Children ages 9 and under are to be supervised at all times by a parent or responsible adult (16 years or older), unless participating in a staff supervised program. Youth will not have direct visual supervision if they are not enrolled in programming and are still expected to comply with Rules & Code of Conduct.
- Persons responsible for any loss or damage to YMCA or that of its members, volunteers or staff will be held personally and financially liable.
- Please wear proper gym, swim and workout attire. No cotton material is allowed to be worn in the pool.
- Please do not leave your locks on the lockers in the locker rooms without rental payment/agreement. Items must be removed daily.
- YMCA staff has the right to determine if any conduct or language is inconsistent with the mission of the YMCA and to act accordingly.
- Failure to follow the above Rules & Code of Conduct will be considered in violation of the "Member Behavior Code" and may result in permanent or temporary suspension of membership privileges.
- The protection of members, volunteers and guests who are participating in programs or are using YMCA facilities is the paramount concern to the Board & Staff of the Shelby YMCA. The YMCA regularly reviews sex offender registries and denies access and/or membership to any person the YMCA learns is a registered sex offender.
